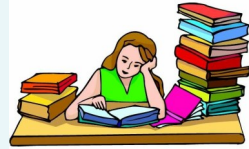


Academic Skills Center

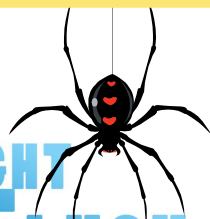


Sleeping Policy
